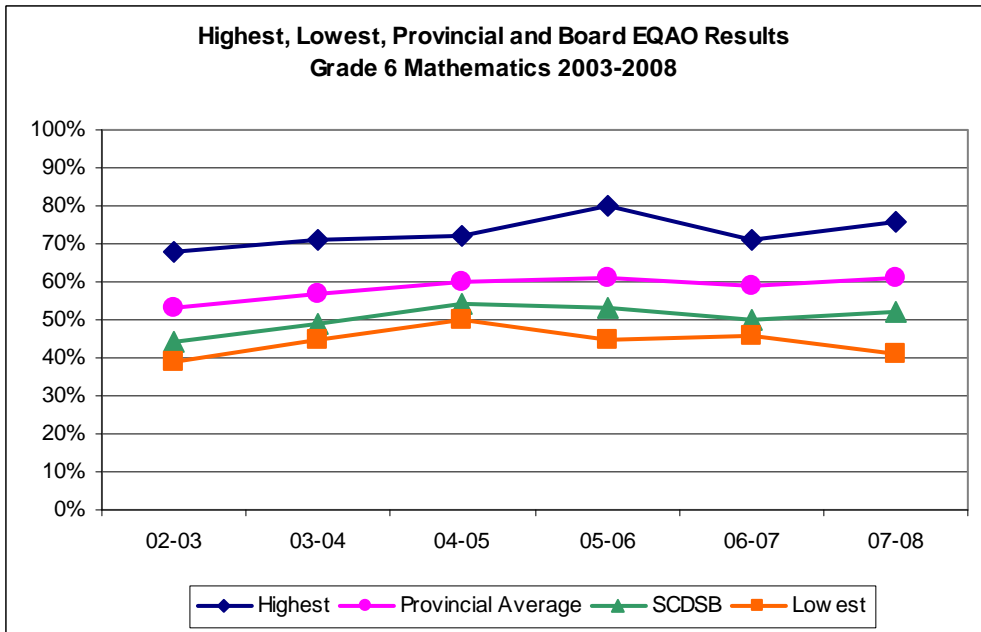
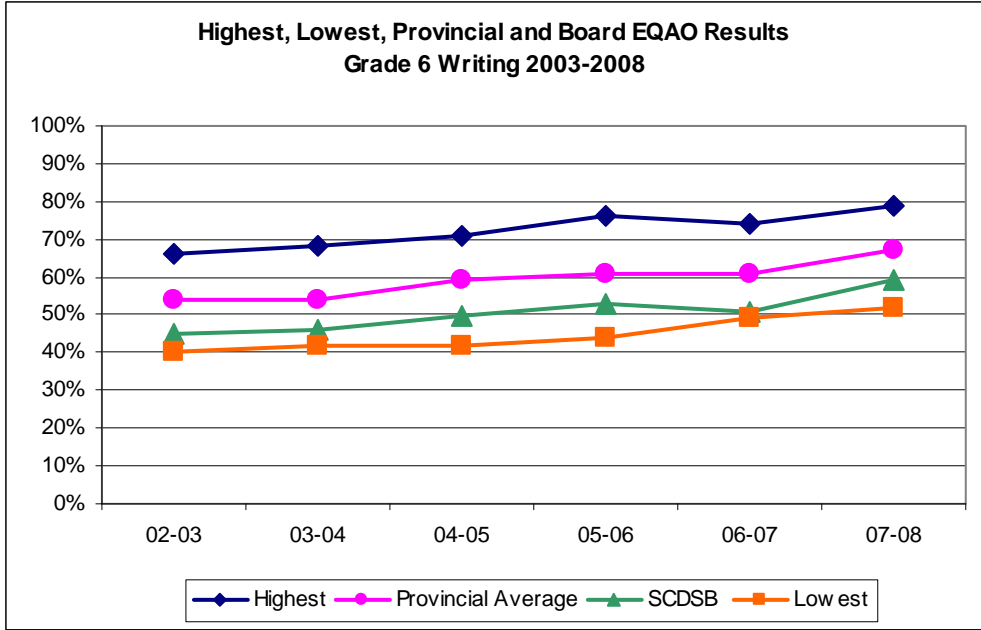
Grade 3 – Percentage of Students at Level 3 and Above





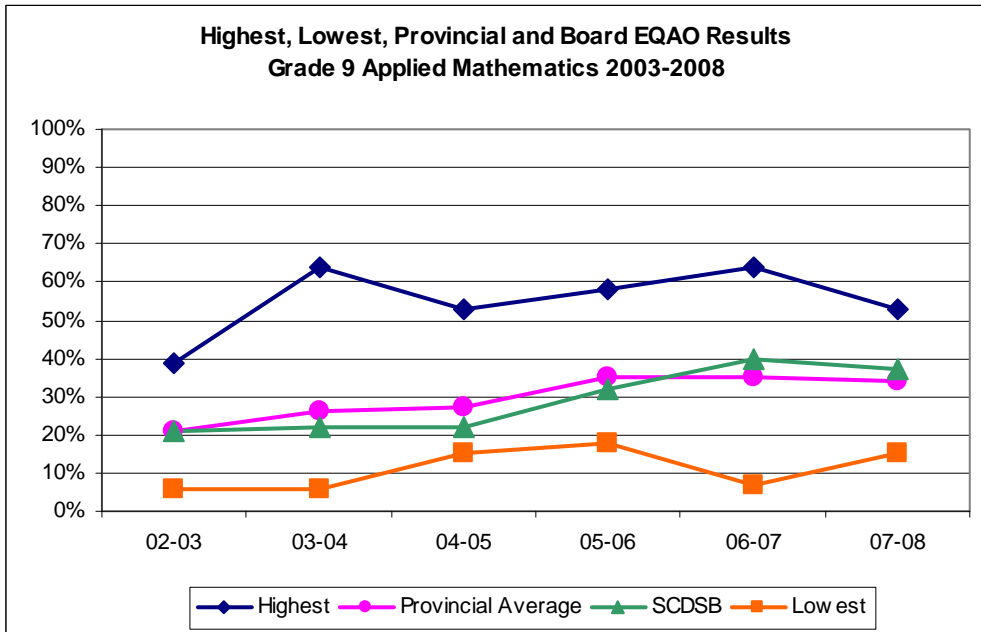
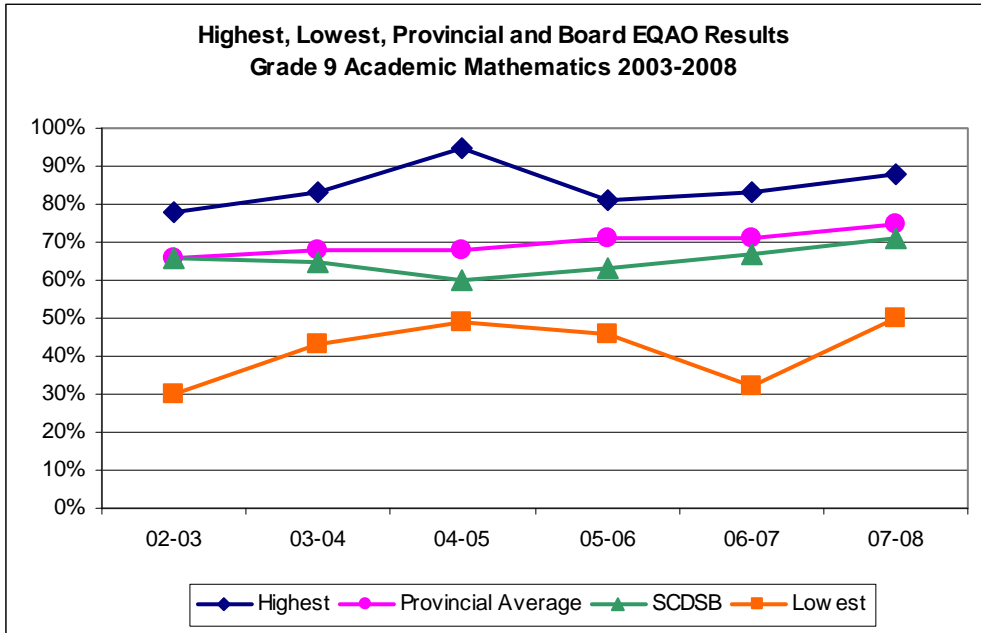
Grade 6 – Percentage of Students at Level 3 and Above





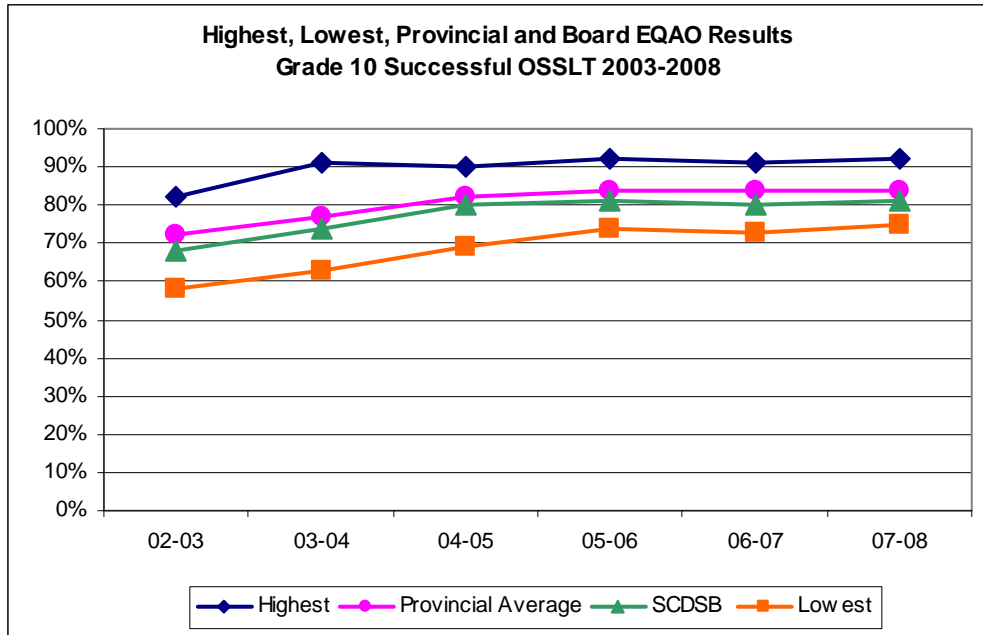


Grade 9 – Percentage of Students at Level 3 and Above

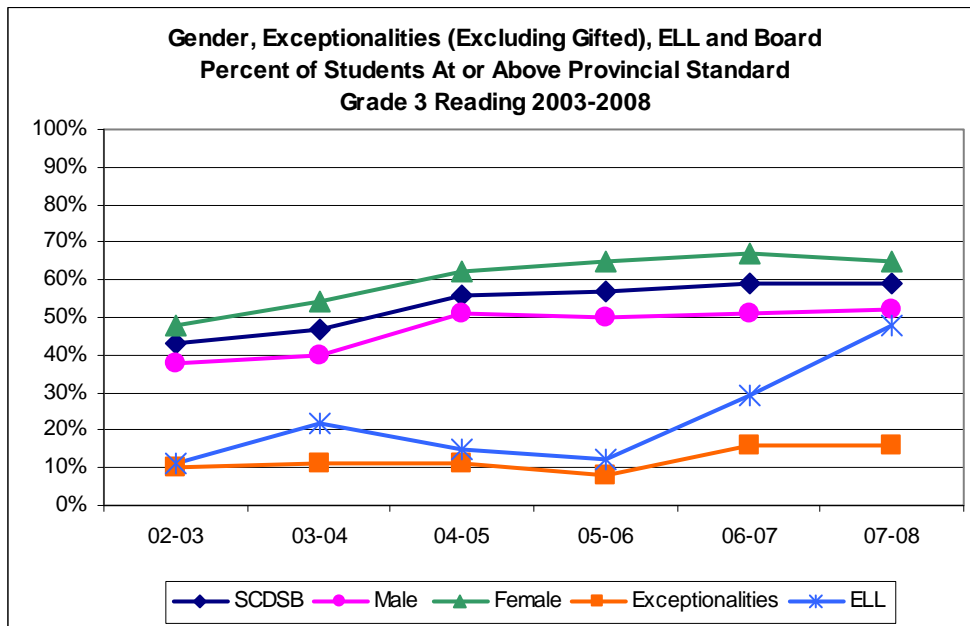




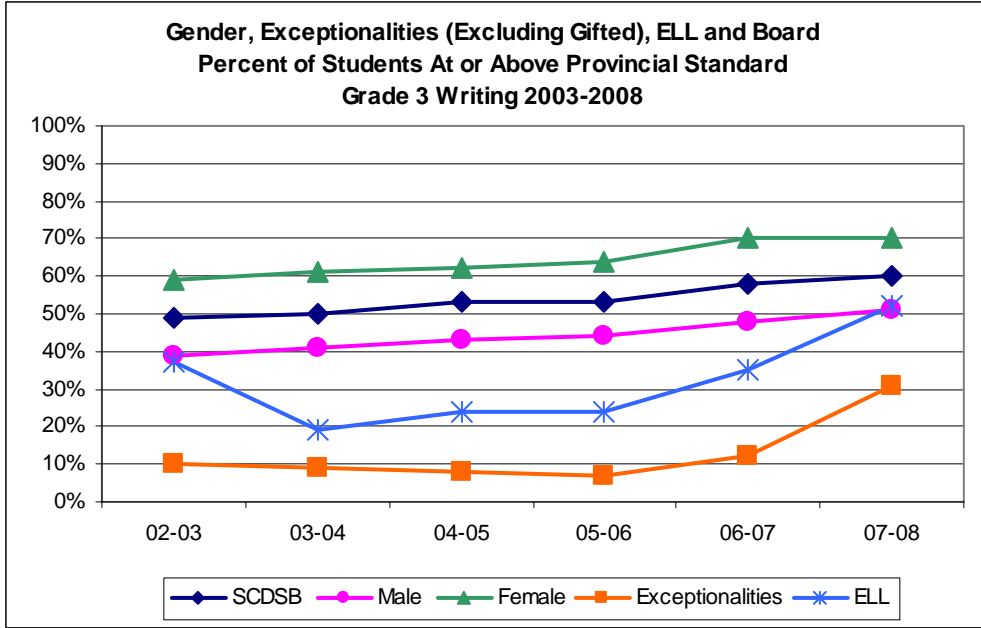
Grade 10 OSSLT – Percentage of Students Successful



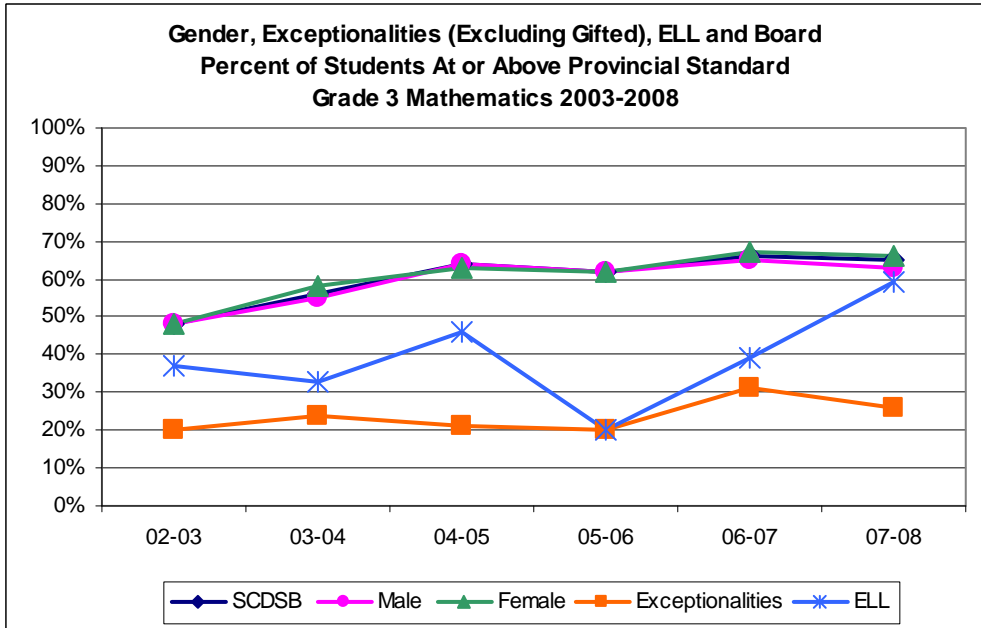

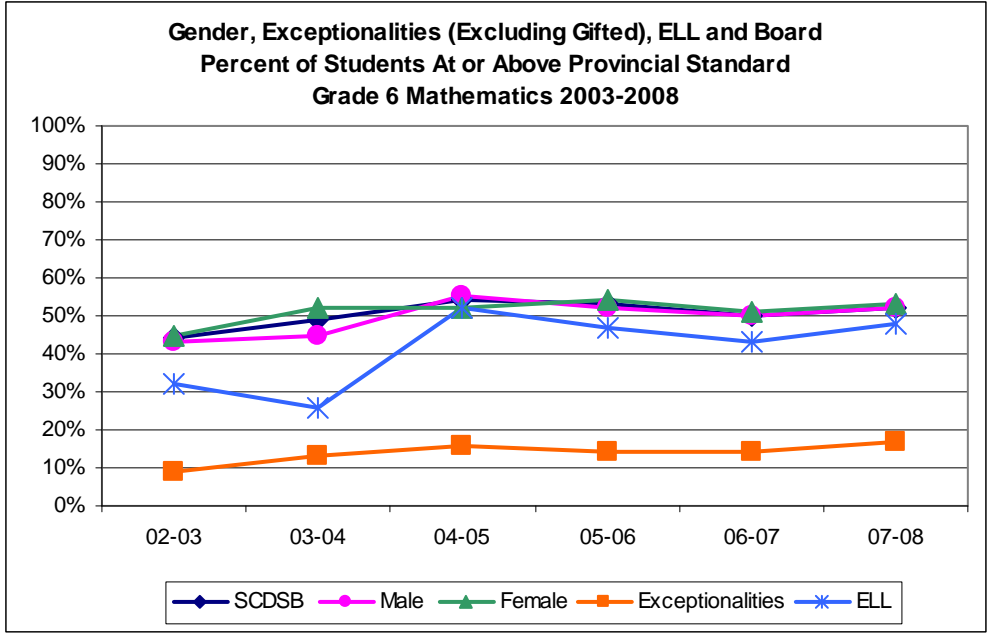

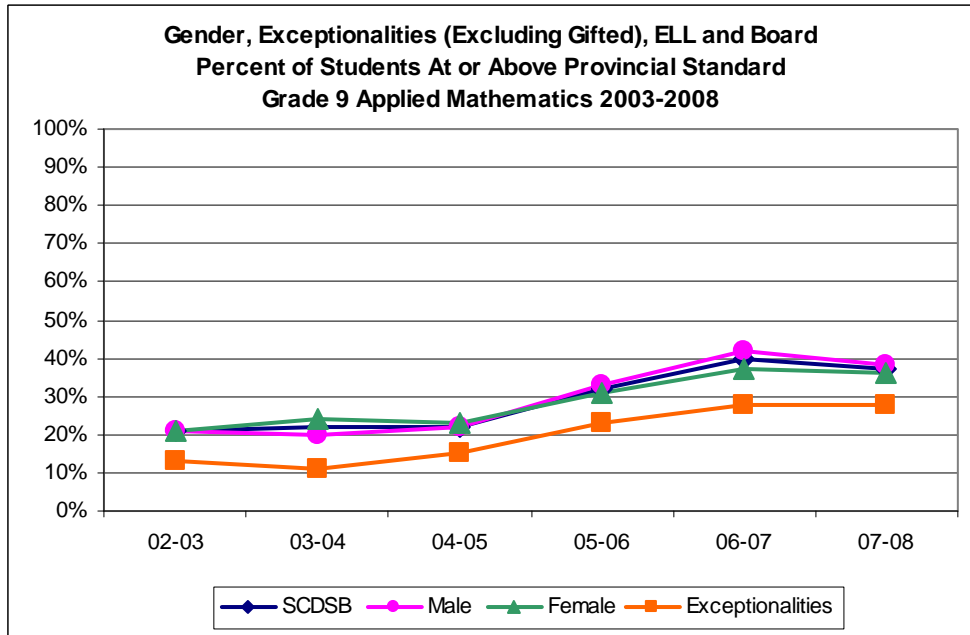
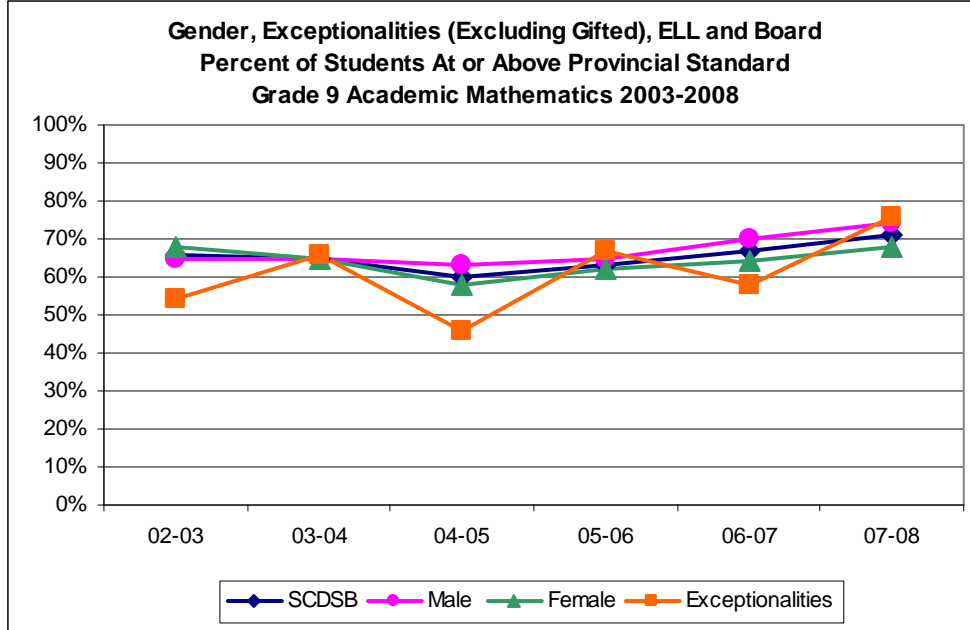


Grade 6 Mathematics

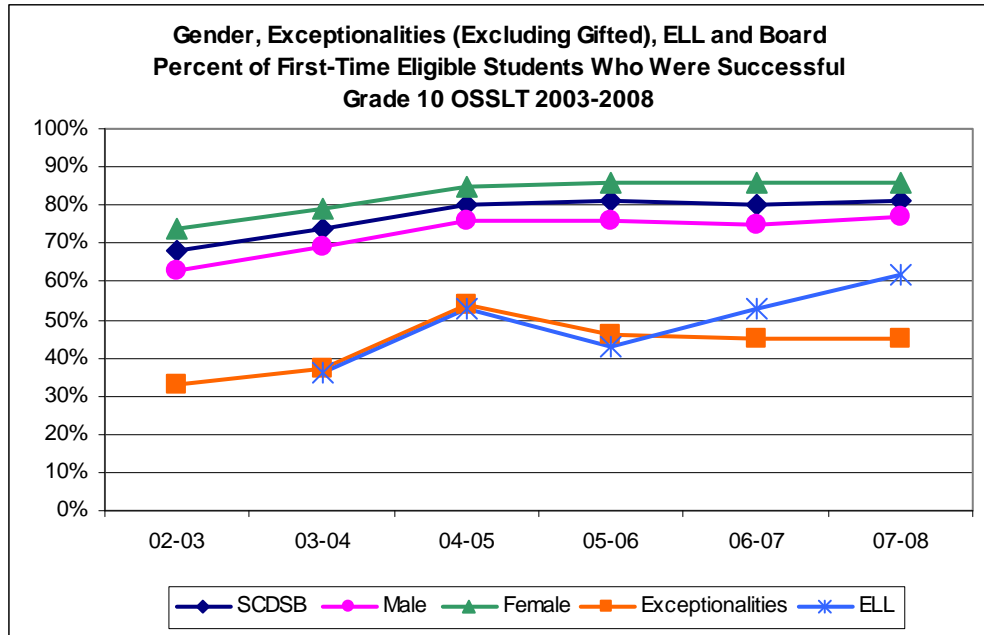
