The goals of elementary sports are skill development, participation and fun.

Intermediate County Tournament Rules

1. The top 2 teams from each region will participate in the county tournament.

2. To maximize participation, all teams are to aim for the recommended roster size of 12 players. For schools submitting rosters with fewer players than the recommended number, there needs to be a discussion between the coach and the principal regarding the reasons for the smaller roster. The discussion should include the number of students trying out for the team, situations that may preclude individual students from participating and other factors.

Once the roster is submitted, there may be situations where the roster is shortened do to injury, school consequences or family emergencies. These incidents should be noted on the original roster and initialed by the principal. Rosters must be submitted prior to the County Tournament.

i) For each game played, the players who start the game must stay on the floor (no substitutions) until one team reaches 13 points. At that time, there will be an official's time-out and substitutions are allowed.

ii) For rosters of 12, all players must start either game one or game two, and remain on the floor until at least the 13th point.

iii) **For the extreme situations of rosters less then 12, a County Roster Form (signed by the principal) must be given to the convenor**

iv) For rosters of 13 or more, the 13th (14th, etc,) player may be substituted into the game at the 8th point. These players must see the court in game 1 or game 2.

v) In a playoff best-of-three, the third game remains 'open'.

vi) The number of substitutions is unlimited, but proper substitutions must still be followed (only 2 players can substitute for each other for a game).

3. Please bring your own set of well marked balls for warm-ups.

4. Games will be played to 25 points with rally point scoring with no maximum during each server rotation.

5. The net height is 200cm for intermediate girls and 220cm for intermediate boys. **The overhand 2-hand pass will be allowed, and the new net rule will be adopted**

6. Proper on court procedure will be followed including the use of time outs (two per game), substitutions, and starting/ending of sets and matches.

7. Up-to-date O.V.A rules apply unless otherwise specified.

8. The championship matches will be the best two (2) out of three (3) sets with a two (2) point margin, no cap. Game 3 of a best of two (2) out of three (3) match is played to 15 points. The winning team must win by at least two (2) points, no cap.

Tie Breaker for Zone and Regional Tournament in Order:

2 Team Tie Break:

- Head-to-head points

3 Team Tie Break:

- total points accumulated in all round-robin 1st games only

- Then, head-to-head points

Coaches:

1. You are reminded that you are responsible for your players and your own conduct. Players are not allowed to roam the host schools. They are to remain in the gym or food booth areas. Food and drinks are not permitted in the gym area and change rooms of the facility in use. Please ensure that your players clean-up after themselves and leave the host school as clean as they found it.
