The program offers a combination of academic and technical training. You will spend much of your time working on projects in labs and studios to develop technical and production skills. Using industry-standard television, audio and computer technology, you will be involved in all aspects of media production.

The Ministry of Education has awarded Barrie North Collegiate a Specialist High Skills Major (SHSM) in the area of Broadcasting: TV, Film and Journalism. **Barrie North is the only school in the province with this special designation!** The SHSM is a ministry-approved specialized program that allows students to focus their learning on specific economic sector while meeting the requirements for the Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD). A SHSM enable students to gain sector-identified preparatory skills and knowledge, make informed career decisions, and to experience a range of customized, career-focussed learning opportunities. Barrie North's focus on Broadcasting involves student participation in real life activities such as: film, festivals, Barrie North's new Radio Station, the morning announcements through our closed circuit TV station (VTV-Viking Television), live news broadcasts, TV and Video competitions and other related activities as they arise.
