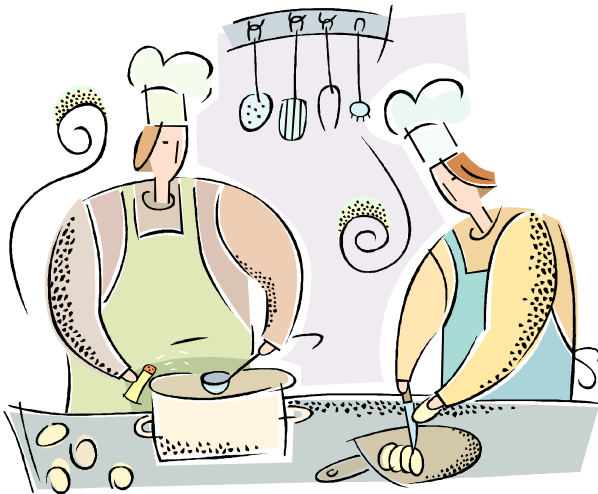


About the Hospitality and Tourism High Skills Major

What is a Specialist High Skills Major?

A high school program that involves:

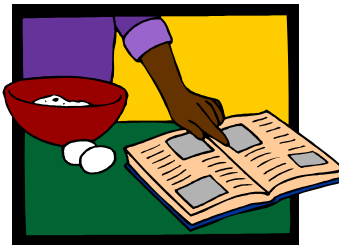
- A defined bundle of courses approved by the Ministry of Education (see middle panel for details)
- Industry recognized training and certifications (see middle panel for details)
- Experiential learning activities - out of school experiences that promote career exploration
- Reach ahead activities - opportunities to explore options for after high school graduation
- Use of the Ontario Skills Passport - used to identify essential skills of Hospitality and Tourism

What does the student gain?

- A distinctive diploma with a Specialist High Skills Major seal
- An advantage over other job/program applicants
- Ministry of Education issued tracking sheet listing qualifications

What is Nantyr's Hospitality Major going to focus on?

- General hospitality and tourism in grade 11
- Double credit Cooking and Baking in grade 12
- Opportunity for Dual Credit - high school /college
- Exploration of training and career options available for post-secondary school
